Dear Parents and Carers,

Schools participate in excursions to enhance and support classroom teaching and learning programs. Your child's class will be going on an excursion to Quarantine Station, Manly on Wednesday, 19 June 2024.

Students will need to be at school by 9.00am, as buses will leave at 9.30am sharp.

Students should bring morning tea and lunch with a refillable drink bottle. Students should bring a minimum of 750ml of water to their excursion. No plastic bags, glad-wrap, glass bottles or cans please. Students will carry their own belongings which need to be in one small excursion bag.

Please ensure your child brings a poncho or raincoat on the day.

Each class will require one volunteer parent on the day, who will accompany the class on the bus to and from Q Station. Please contact your class teacher if you would like to help on this excursion. All volunteers will need to have completed the Appendix 5 Working With Children Check – available for download from the school website, or copy from the office.
