2. Principal Report – Andy Rankin

Thank you to P & C for the past years efforts. In particular Garden Club, Uniform Shop, Canteen, OOSH, Band and Strings for their efforts.

Learning from Home has had a significant impact on the students & staff. Extremely difficult & a massive learning curve for all. Learning from home resulted in huge amounts of work for the teachers with some having to work 12-15hour days to keep up. Level 3 restrictions should stay in place until the end of 2021.

Naplan results were varied with Year 3 being excellent, and year 5 being a little below expectation. The subsequent 'check-in' tests results saw all grades more on track. Literacy results were very good with Numeracy requiring a little more work.

School Enrolments for 2022 are down. Expecting to drop 2 classes for next year but keeping all staff. Approximately 105 Kindergarten enrolments.

A new position of A.P Curriculum & Instruction will be held at the school.

Cameras are in place with a few more to go up. Shool has funded \$40k for these.

2 days of Professional learning for Staff in 2022.

2022 will see the launch of a new program called "Unleash your Potential" to help students grow and develop.
